2004 MP's Recontesting in 2009 Lok Sabha Elections

नई दिल्ली, दिनांक 4 मई, 2009 : असोसियेशन फॉर डेमोक्रेटिक रिफॉर्म्स एवम् नॅशनल इलेक्सन वॉच,(NEW) एक राष्ट्रीय अभियान है जिसमें 1200 से अधिक NGO और कई दूसरे नागरिक संगठन साथ मिलकर चुनाव सुधार, प्रजातांत्रिक सुधार एवं सुशासन के लिये पार्टीद्वारा घोषित लोकसभा के लिये उम्मीदवारों की निगरानी कर रहे हैं. ADR ने अब तक लोकसभा 2004 से, 229 ऐसे सांसदों के हलफनामों का विश्लेषण किया है जो 2009 में दुबारा लोक सभा चुनाव लड़ रहे हैं. ADR ने 24 राज्यों तथा सभी संघ राज्य क्षेत्रों के उम्मीदवारों की संपत्ति बदलाव की तुलना की है . इन सभी उम्मीदवारों की सूचना अब <http://myneta.info> पर भी उपलब्ध है.

संपत्ति तुलना के मुख्य बिंदु:-

1. 2004 और 2009 के लिए कुल उम्मीदवार जिनके हलफनामों NEW द्वारा मिलाए गये हैं = 229
2. इस रिपोर्ट में उन सांसदों के हलफनामों पर विचार नहीं किया गया जो की ठीक से स्कैन नहीं हुए या जिनके पृष्ठ गायब हैं या जो हाथ से लिखे गये हैं इसलिए ठीक से पढ़े नहीं जा सकें.
3. शेष चरणों के चुनावों के पूर्ण होने के पश्चात आडर सारे हलफनामों का विश्लेषण कर एक पूर्ण रिपोर्ट निकलेगा.
4. 2004 और 2009 में उम्मीदवारों द्वारा घोषित संपत्ति में बहुत हेर फेर पाया गया है
5. कुछ सांसदों ने अपनी संपत्ति बिना मूल्य के घोषित किया है. NEW ने ऐसी संपत्ति का मूल्या शून्य लिया है. ऐसे उम्मीदवार जिनकी संपत्ति घोषणा में ये सब कमी हैं, इस रिपोर्ट में उनके आगे (*) का निशान लगाया गया है.
6. विचार किए गये सांसदों की संपत्ति में अधिकतम प्रतिशत वृद्धि उत्तर प्रदेश के Mohd. Tahir* की रहा है - 9137%. दूसरे स्थान पर कर्नाटका के C H Vijaya Shankar हैं- 6526.23%. इसके बाद पश्चिम बंगाल की Susmita Bauri (3151.52%), महाराष्ट्र के Suresh Ganpatrao Waghmare* (2159.64%), उत्तर प्रदेश के Akshay Pratap Singh Gopal Ji (1841.06%), और राजस्थान के Sachin Pilot (1746%) हैं
7. विचार किए गये सांसदों की संपत्ति में अधिकतम प्रतिशत कमी कर्नाटका के S. Bangarappa की रही है (-79%). दूसरे स्थान पर जम्मू और कश्मीर के Ch. Lal Singh (-67.44%) और उड़ीसा के Prasanna Kumar Patasani (-66.74%) हैं.
8. इस सूची के अनुसार फिर से चुनाव लड़ रहे सांसदों की औसत व्यक्तिगत संपत्ति में वृद्धि 298% या 2.67 करोड़ है.

Asset comparison 2004 MPs recontesting in 2009 Lok Sabha Elections

New Delhi, May 4, 2009: Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and National Election Watch (NEW), a nationwide campaign comprising of more than 1200 NGOs and other citizen led organizations, has been working on electoral reforms and improving democracy and governance in India. It has analysed affidavits filed in 2004 and 2009 for 229 MPs recontesting in 2009 elections from 24 states and UTs and compared the change in assets. All the candidate profiles considered in this report are now available at <http://myneta.info>.

Highlights of Asset Comparison

1. Total MPs whose affidavits were matched by NEW for both 2004 and 2009 elections = 229
2. All MPs whose affidavits were either not properly scanned or had missing pages or whose entries were hand written and thus illegible have not been considered for this report.
3. We will come out with another complete report as soon as we have processed all the affidavits for all the remaining phases etc.
4. There have been several discrepancies in how assets have been declared by candidates in 2004 and in 2009.
5. Some MPs declared few assets without giving the value, NEW has taken such assets to be zero. Candidates who made such declarations have been marked with a (*) in this report.
6. The maximum % increase in assets among the analysed MPs has been 9137% for Mohd Tahir* from Uttar Pradesh. This is followed by C H Vijaya Shankar from Karnataka (6526.23 %), Susmita Bauri from West Bengal (3151.52 %), Suresh Ganpatrao Waghmare* from Maharashtra (2159.64%) and Akshay Pratap Singh Gopal ji from Uttar Pradesh (1841.06%), followed by Sachin Pilot from Rajasthan at 1746%.
7. The maximum % decrease in assets among analysed MPs has been for S Bangarappa from Karnataka (-79%), Ch Lal Singh from J&K (-67.44%) and Prasanna Kumar Patasani from Orissa (-66.74%)
8. The average individual asset increase of recontesting MPs in this list is 298% or 2.67 Cr
